I. GENERAL INFORMATION

One semester credit hour is granted for 33 actual study and/or work hours. Research shows sermons and Bible lessons average 10 hours of study, prayer, and development time. For example, submitting proof of ten original sermons would verify granting of 3 semester credit hours. A maximum of 15 credit hours can be granted between Experiential Learning Credits and Credit by Examination and can be applied to any degree program.

Bible Lessons Development	ELC001ENG	Developing a study guide or lessons for Sunday School, Discipleship Programs, etc.
Sermon Development	ELC002ENG	Developing 10 messages for preaching
Book Development	ELC003ENG	Publishing a book- 1 page = 1 hour of actual study/work
Mission Trip Leadership	ELC004ENG	Providing leadership development for mission trips
Church Program Development	ELC005ENG	Developing and leading some type of program such as VBS, Sunday School, visitation, discipleship, and promotional, etc.
Church/Ministry Planting	ELC006ENG	Starting a new church or ministry
Seminar Development	ELC007ENG	Organizing and running a workshop or seminar
Staff Experience/Training	ELC008ENG	Serving a minimum of one year, at least 20 hours/week, as a staff member of a church or ministry. Serving in different positions may qualify for additional credits.
Misc. Training and Development	ELC009ENG	Special study and or work projects that enhanced the student's knowledge base may be considered by your dean.
