Course Description/Overview

This is a continuation from where Advanced Apologetics I ended. A study of “The New Evidence That Demands a Verdict” will further document historical evidence of the Christian faith. This course will, in outline form, give the student the information needed to locate supporting evidence for the Christian faith. Part I of the textbook addresses the trustworthiness of the Bible. Part II of the text will provide historical evidence and support for Jesus’ claim to be God. Part III of the textbook will address criticism of the Bible. Part IV will go into answering skepticism.

The student will learn to defend the Christian faith from a Biblical and logical point of view.
The student will learn to defend the Christian faith with an ability far beyond the average Christian today.
The student will be strengthened in his or her own assurance of the validity of the Christian faith.
